At Heartland Plastic, we are closely monitoring all updates regarding the Coronavirus illness and will continue to update our patients on our practice and its operations as changes are necessary.

- ⇒ If you are sick, running a fever, or have a new onset cough, we recommend canceling your appointment and staying home until you contact your family doctor.
- ⇒ For scheduled surgery, currently both major accrediting agencies for ambulatory surgery centers AAASC and the AAAASF have not changed any recommendations for elective surgery. If you are concerned about the safety and wish to reschedule, we understand and will try to reschedule your case in 3 months without any loss of scheduling deposits.
- ⇒ Our staff is taking extra precautions with all aspects of patient care, from handling of paperwork to surgical procedures. We are increasing sterilization procedures by wiping down all furniture each morning before the office opens, at lunch and again with our scheduled cleaning at the end of the day. All countertops and exam room beds will continue to be cleaned after each patient visit, as usual.
- ⇒ We encourage patients to keep their post-operative appointments unless they are ill.
- ⇒ We ask patients to limit accompanying visitors to 1 person unless there are unusual circumstances.
- ⇒ If at your appointment you feel more comfortable waiting in your car until your appointment time, rather than the waiting area, please call us when you are in the parking lot and we will make arrangements with you.
